As a follow up to my phone conversation with you this afternoon I would like to clarify a comment I made several months ago in a letter to the City and your office re our client's application to the MLCC and the City for a transfer of the liquor license for Bennedetto's Steakhouse. At that time I indicated in my letter to the City that there would be no change in the operation of the business or the building itself. Since then our client has decided to move forward with changing the exterior façade of the Steakhouse to conform to the exterior façade of the Hotel. 

1. What is the applicant's management experience in the alcohol/liquor Business?

I have been managing hotels and am very capable of managing and operating this business.

2. What is the applicant's general business management experience?

I have been managing hotels for the last year or so.

3. What is the applicant's general business reputation?

My reputation is one of honesty and hard work. I am dedicated to my job and known as a hard worker.

4. What is the applicant's moral character?

Excellent.

5. What is the applicant's financial status and ability to build and / or operate the proposed facility on which the proposed liquor license is to be located?

I have the financial support of my parents. The restaurant is in existence and I do not need additional funds to take over this operation.

6. What are the applicant's past criminal convictions involving moral turpitude, violence or alcoholic liquor?

None.

7. Does the applicant use alcoholic beverages to excess?

Socially only.

8. What is the effect that the issuance of a license would have upon the economic development of the surrounding area?

No adverse effect. This Hotel has been licensed for many years and is a longtime member of The Novi business community.

9. What effect would the issuance of a license have on the health, welfare and safety of the general public?

No adverse effect - Hotel is presently licensed.

10. Has the applicant received responses from the police department, building department and/or fire department with regard to the proposed facility?

None.

11. What is the public need or convenience for issuance of a liquor license for this facility at the proposed location?

We are transferring ownership of the existing Hotel liquor license and permits.

12. What is the uniqueness of the proposed facility when contrasted against other existing or proposed facilities, and the compatibility of the proposed facility to surrounding architecture and land use?

N/A - existing operation.

13. Does the facility to which the proposed liquor license is to be issued comply with the applicable building, plumbing, electrical and fire prevention codes and zoning statutes and ordinances applicable to the City of Novi? Has applicant received information from the appropriate departments?

This Hotel will comply with all Novi's ordinances and codes.

14. What effect will the facility to which the proposed liquor license is to be issued have upon vehicular and pedestrian traffic in the area?

None – Hotel is presently licensed.

15. What is the proximity of the proposed business facility to other similarly situated licensed liquor facilities?

Other licensed establishments are located in shopping center adjacent to the Hotel and across Novi Road and I-96 from the Hotel.

16. What is the proximity of the proposed facility to complimentary uses such as office and commercial development?

Existing Hotel is adjacent to several retail malls or centers and extensive commercial as well as is in close proximity to the Rock Financial Showplace.

17. What effect would the proposed facility have upon the surrounding neighborhood and/or business establishments, including impacts upon residential areas, church and school districts?

No adverse effect – no residential property or church/schools are anywhere near this Hotel.

18. What proposed or actual commitments are being made by the applicant to establish permanency in the community?

Family owns the Hotel property and rare all longtime residences of this area.

19. What utilities are available to serve the facility?

Full service in existence.

20. What other factors should the Novi City Council consider?

We are simply transferring ownership of the existing liquor license for this Hotel.

Questionnaire C – Police Department Background Information for Liquor License

General Information

Obtain Questionnaire C from the Novi Police Department. Applicants have thirty (30) days to complete Questionnaire C, from the date it is received. Attach all documents as requested. If thirty (30) days are not sufficient, the applicant must notify the police investigator with reason(s) for the delay. If, after thirty (30) days, no contact has been made with the investigator, the investigation will be **CLOSED** and a report will be submitted by the Novi Chief of Police to the Michigan Liquor Control Commission (M.L.C.C.).

The police investigation process of a new liquor license or transfer request is lengthy and usually takes several weeks to complete. The goal of the police department is to ensure that all M.L.C.C. licensed businesses within the City of Novi are managed and operated to protect and serve the citizens of the community.

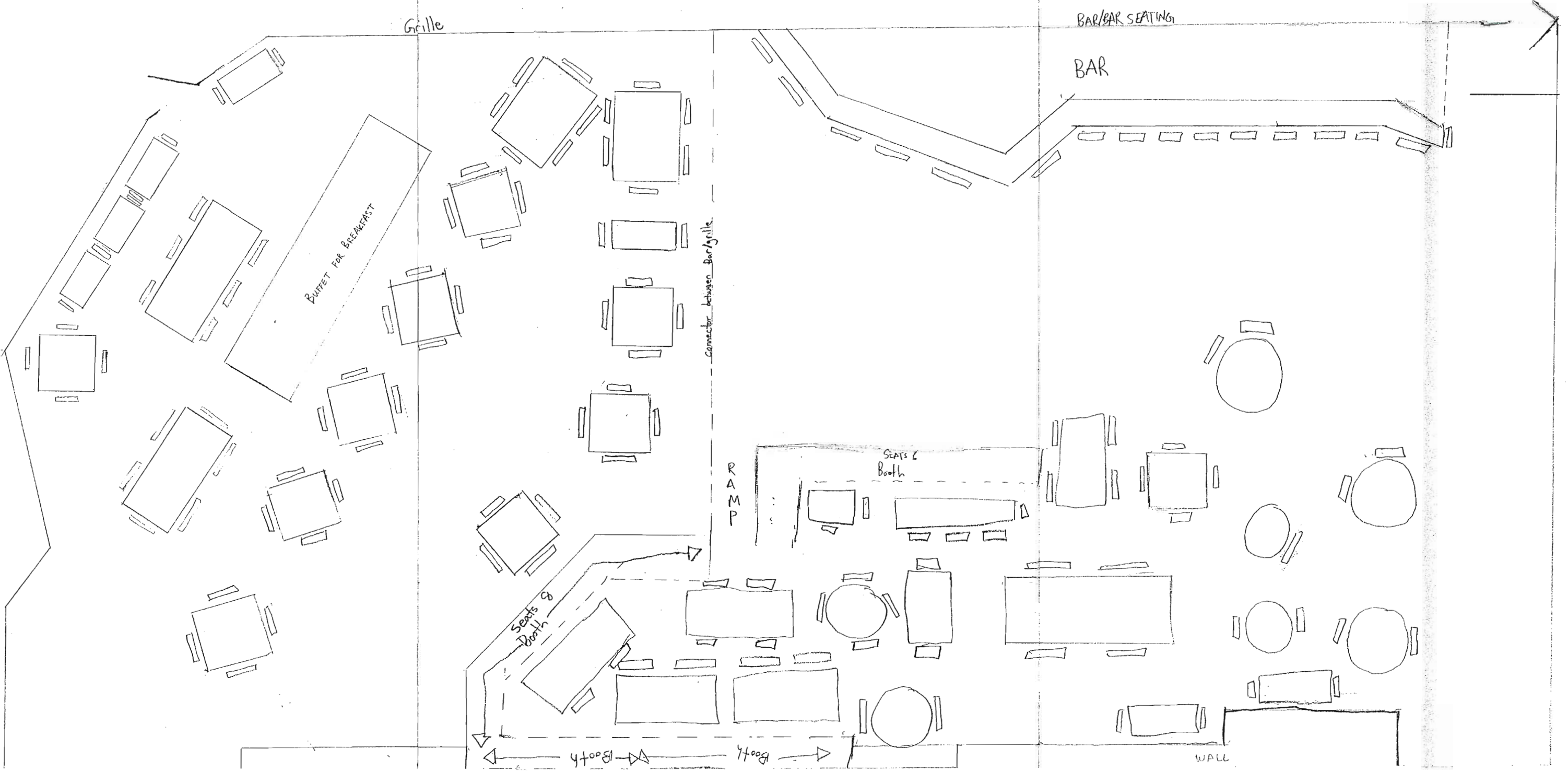
Once a license is issued, the licensed location must continue to conform to all local and state statutes, laws, and ordinances, as well as, the Michigan Liquor Control Act and the Michigan Liquor Control Code Rules. All businesses possessing a liquor license of any type issued by the M.L.C.C. are personally inspected by the Novi Police Department. Occasional police operations will be conducted to ensure that minors are not possessing or receiving the sale of alcoholic beverages.

Guidelines

1.The applicant must have already filed an application with the M.L.C.C. prior to receiving and completing the Novi Police Department’s Liquor License Questionnaire.

2.Applicant’s requesting on-premise types of liquor licenses must have already completed and submitted the appropriate applications (A and B) and requirements with the Novi Planning and Community Development Department. The applicant must adhere to all City of Novi policies and procedures pertaining to liquor licensing.

3.Upon receipt of the Novi Liquor License Questionnaire C, the applicant must complete and return it to the Novi Police Department within thirty (30) days. **All questions must be answered and the required attachments included.**
