SUBJECT Approval of resolution to add Brightmoor Christian Church, Deerfield Elementary and Fox Run Village to the City of Novi's polling locations and change boundaries for Voting Precincts effective August 2008 Primary.

CITY MANAGER APPROVAL

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

With the population growth over the last 7 years, it has become necessary to re-arrange voting precincts and polling locations with the exception of Precincts 1-5 (neither boundaries nor locations will change). One of the considerations in this proposal was to have the new precinct borders follow school district boundaries, thus eliminating the need for up to four different ballot styles in a precinct.

With Council's approval, it is being proposed to add the following polling locations: 1) Brightmoor Christian Church, Deerfield Elementary and Fox Run Village. Each proposed location has been contacted and we have reached agreement with them to become a polling location beginning with the August Primary 2008.

The Election Commission met on Monday, November 19, 2007 and unanimously approved the proposal Section 3.1 of the Charter states that the Council shall fix the location of the polling places. Therefore, I've attached a resolution for Council's consideration that details the proposed changes.

In order to begin the process with the Secretary of State, proposed changes must be approved by City Council, submitted at least 210 days in advance of the August Primary and forwarded to the State Bureau of Elections.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Approval of resolution to add Brightmoor Christian Church, Deerfield Elementary and Fox Run Village to the City of Novi's polling locations and change boundaries for Voting Precincts effective August 2008 Primary.

RESOLUTION APPROVING POLLING LOCATIONS AND CHANGES IN BOUNDARIES FOR VOTING PRECINCTS

WHEREAS, The City of Novi has 17 voting precincts and 13 polling locations, as established in 1995. Since that time, increases in demographic factors and the election consolidation legislation of 2005 have created a need to expand the number of precincts to 21 and the number of polling locations to 15;

WHEREAS, All planned precinct boundary changes were granted by the local Election Commission and must be approved by the City Council;

WHEREAS, The rearrangement of precinct boundaries are governed under Michigan Election Law, MCL 168.654-661, and must be submitted to the Michigan Department of State by January 10, 2008; and

WHEREAS, These proposed changes will follow all four (4) school district boundaries and reduce the length of lines, thus encouraging voter participation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, after review of all precincts and potential polling locations, the Novi City Council approves the following voting precinct changes:

CHAPTER 3. NOMINATIONS AND ELECTIONS*

*State law references: Michigan election laws, MCL 168.1 et seq., MSA 6.1001 et seq.; mandatory that Charter provide for the time, manner and means of holding elections, MCL 117.3(c), MSA 5.2073 (c), MSA 5.2073(c).

Section 3.1. Election districts; voting precincts.

The City shall constitute one election district and such voting precincts as the Election Commission may establish. The Council shall fix the location of the polling places.



State law references: Mandatory that Charter provide for one or more wards, MCL 117.3(e), MSA 5.2073(e); election precincts, MCL 168.654 et seq., MSA 6.1654 et seq.

Section 3.2. Qualifications of electors.

The residents of the City having the qualifications of electors in the State of Michigan and registered with the City shall be electors of the City.

State law references: Qualifications for registration as elector, MCL 168.492, MSA 6.1492.

Section. 3.3. Election procedures.

The election of all City officers shall be on a nonpartisan basis. Otherwise, general election laws shall apply to and control all procedures relating to registration and elections unless otherwise provided herein.

State law references: Mandatory that Charter provide for registration of electors, MCL 117.3(c), MSA 5.2073(c); registration of electors generally, MCL 168.491 et seq., MSA 6.1491 et seq.

Section 3.4. Election Commission.

The Election Commission shall consist of the City Clerk and two (2) members appointed by the Council. Such Commission shall have the duties and powers conferred on city election commissioners by statute. The City Clerk shall act as Chairman of the Commission.

Section 3.5. Election Inspectors.

The Election Commission shall, before each election, appoint for each precinct of the City a Board of Inspectors of each election, consisting of not less than three (3) qualified electors, and shall fix their compensation.

Section 3.6. Board of Canvassers.
