BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City's consulting engineer for this project (Stantec) administered the construction contract for the Fire Station No. 1 Parking Lot Improvements in 2005. Stantec has executed and submitted the attached documents verifying the final contract payment amount that is due to the construction contractor, ABC Paving Company of Trenton, MI (Stantec's Final Engineer's Certificate, attached).

The parking lot repaving work was performed by the contractor in 2005 in substantial compliance with the plans and specifications, and final payment in the amount of \$4,748.74 is appropriate. In addition, the City Attorney has reviewed supporting documentation and found it to be in an acceptable form. The original contract was approved at the October 10, 2005 City Council meeting in the amount of \$68,925.30. The delay in closing out the project was caused by the contractor and turnover that occurred with their staff. The final payment brings the total in construction expenditures on this project to \$65,359.31 (a net decrease).

**RECOMMENDED ACTION:** Approval of the final payment to ABC Paving Company for the Fire Station No. 1 Parking Lot Improvements in the amount of \$4,784.74.
