SUBJECT: Approval to award a construction contract for the 2010 Capital Preventative Maintenance - Major Roads Phase 2, to Pro Line Asphalt Paving Corp., the low bidder, in the amount of \$156,025.

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The second phase of the proposed 2010 Roadway Capital Preventative Maintenance Program (CPM) includes the repair of four City major road segments, summarized in the following table:

A location map is attached showing the location of the selected road segments.

This project includes multiple CPM treatment methods that were determined during the design process based on our asset management approach, and designed to extend the life of the City's roads in the most cost-effective manner. Two alternates were included with this project with the intent to maximize the capital preventative maintenance budget. However, the bids received were not low enough to allow inclusion of the alternates in this contract. Alternate 1 is an asphalt overlay on West Park Drive to cover the proposed patched areas and provide a uniform paved surface, both for aesthetic reasons and to seal up existing cracks and new joints in the pavement surface. Alternate 2 involves the use of a reinforcing fabric interlayer on Old Novi Road placed below the proposed asphalt overlay, which is an emerging technology used to reduce reflective cracking (where cracks in existing pavement reflect, or creep, upward into new pavement overlay).

Five bids were received and opened on September 15, 2010 following a public bid solicitation period. The lowest bidder is Pro Line Asphalt (Pro Line). Pro Line's bid is recommended as being in the best interest of the City as it is responsive (i.e., Pro Line has complied with all requirements of the bidding instructions) and it is the lowest price. (URS's award recommendation letter including the bid tabulation dated September 20, 2010 is attached.) A summary of the bids is as follows:

Staff is recommending that the project be awarded to Pro Line, the low bidder, in the amount of \$156,024. Pro Line has successfully completed the Crowe/Ingersol repaving and the Meadowbrook (Grand River to Cherry Hill) repaving projects.

The approved project budget is \$200,000 of which \$14,060 was awarded for design engineering in July 2010, \$156,025 is recommended for award to Pro Line for construction, and \$26,593 is recommended for award to URS for construction engineering services (a separate item on this agenda) for total contract awards in the amount of \$196,678.

Construction is scheduled to begin October 2010 and completion is anticipated in November 2010.

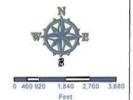

Attached is the Bid Tabulation for the above referenced project. Five (5) bids were received. Competition appears to have been adequate. All bids appear to be balanced and there are no irregularities noted in the bids.

One mathematical error was found in the lowest bid, from Pro Line Asphalt Paving Corp.. Correction of this error increased their Base Bid amount by \$11.05 from the "As Read" amount of \$173,233.28 to \$173,244.33. These bid amounts include the item for Crew Days to cover inspection costs. This correction did not change the order of bidders.

Pro Line Asphalt Paving Corporation is the low bidder for the Base project. Pro Line also is the low bidder if either or both of the Alternates is awarded.

We reviewed the Bidders Qualifications and Experience Statement submitted by Pro Line and called some of the references listed. The references indicated that that Pro Line performed well on past projects.

We therefore recommend award of the contract to the low bidder, Pro Line Asphalt Paving Corporation for the Base Bid Amount (excluding crew days) of \$156,024.33.
