SUBJECT: Approval to award a construction contract for Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation in CMOM program areas B, C1, and G to Inland Waters Pollution Control, Inc., the low bidder, in the amount of \$553,441.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

A sanitary sewer Capacity Management, Operations, and Maintenance (CMOM) program was initiated by the City in 2005 as a multi-phased program to perform longrange planning, improve operation and maintenance of the system, and ensure the integrity of the sanitary sewer system. One of the key components of the CMOM program is the evaluation of the sanitary sewer infrastructure to determine areas that require repair - primarily to prevent the infiltration and inflow of clean water (i.e., groundwater and storm water run-off) from entering the system and being unnecessarily treated at the Detroit wastewater treatment plant. Infiltration and inflow that enter the system will increase treatments costs and decrease available capacity.

Over the past several years, the Water and Sewer Division has cleaned and televised these areas to identify defective segments of pipe that are in need of repair. The scope of this project includes the rehabilitation of the areas identified by Water and Sewer staff in three areas within the City, identified as Areas B, C1 and G (see attached location map from the CMOM Phase II report). Of the lines televised, 192 locations in 117 sections of sewer pipe were identified for repair. To put the rehabilitation effort into perspective, this project represents the rehabilitation of roughly one-third of the City's sanitary sewage collection system network.

Spalding DeDecker Associates (SDA) was selected to provide assistance in completing the evaluation of these portions of the system, and for recommending repair techniques based on their pipe rehabilitation expertise. SDA developed a report recommending corrective maintenance to be completed (attached). The repair techniques include the cleaning and removal of obstructions and accumulated deposits, cured-in-place pipe lining for the severe defects, and spot grouting for some of the minor defects.

The CMOM Phase II report stated the need for an annual rehabilitation program that would be intended to evaluate the City's sanitary sewer system on a regular cycle. However, since this is the first year for the rehabilitation program, a larger project including the Areas B, C1 and G is being proposed to catch-up with the existing cleaning and televising schedule.

Six bids were received and opened on August 14, 2012 following a public bid solicitation period. The lowest bidder is Inland Waters Pollution Control, Inc. Inland Water's bid is recommended as being in the best interest of the City as it is responsive (i.e., Inland Waters has complied with all requirements of the bidding instructions) and it is the lowest price for the selected option. (SDA's award recommendation letter including the bid tabulation dated August 17, 2012 is attached.) A summary of the six bids is as follows:



Construction is scheduled to begin in fall 2012 and completion is anticipated in early 2013.

Dear Mr. Hayes:

On August 14, 2012 at 2:00 pm, construction bids were opened and publicly read at the City of Novi for the Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Areas B, C1 & G project.

The City Clerk's office received six (6) bids for this project. The apparent low bidder, Inland Waters Pollution Control, Inc., submitted a bid price of \$596,490.75 (\$553,440.75 excluding Crew Days). Subsequent to the bid opening, Spalding DeDecker Associates (SDA) reviewed all of the bids received and prepared the attached bid tabulation for the project.

Submitted unit prices were reviewed against those being currently seen in the construction industry. SDA believes the unit prices are within an acceptable range for this type of work.

SDA has also reviewed contractor qualifications and a list of references from Inland Waters Pollution Control, Inc. Based upon our review of the submitted qualifications and a check of the references, SDA finds that Inland Waters Pollution Control, Inc. is qualified to perform the required construction.

Though it does not affect our recommendation, it should be noted that a lawsuit has been filed by the Macomb County Drain Drainage District against 40 defendants, including Inland Waters Pollution Control, Inc., over the work performed in 2004 and 2005 in connection with the emergency repair of the collapsed sanitary interceptor and associated sink hole on 15 Mile Road. At this time, the Court has stayed the lawsuit after Inland Waters Pollution Control, Inc. and numerous other defendants filed a motion for summary judgment against Macomb County Drain Drainage District's complaint.

It is our recommendation that the project be awarded to the low bidder, Inland Waters Pollution Control, Inc., for the Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Areas B, C1 & G project for the bid price of \$596,490.75 (\$553,440.75 excluding Crew Days).

Upon award by the City Council our office will coordinate the execution of the Contract Agreement, Bonds and Insurance Policy as well as any other necessary documents with the selected contractor, and issuance of a Notice to Proceed upon execution of the contract documents.
