

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In May of 2010, the Novi Fire Department received City Council approval to apply for the 2010 Assistance to Firefighters Grant for a turn-out gear extractor. The grant required matching funds of \$4,400. In November of 2010 we received notification that the grant was not funded.

During this same time, the Dearborn Heights Fire Department submitted a regional grant. This grant was a collaboration of thirteen (13) Fire Departments from the Western Wayne County Fire Department Mutual Aid Association for the purchase of Co-oximeter machines that measure the carboxyhemoglobin levels in firefighters and civilians exposed to carbon monoxide poisoning. The units cost \$4,000 each, with a match of 20% or \$800. Novi has been notified that we are slated to receive one unit provided we fund the \$800 match. Dearborn Heights Fire Department is the host agency for this grant and will distribute all equipment and maintain all records of the grant process.

The Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) has helped firefighters and other first responders to obtain critically needed equipment, protective gear, emergency vehicles, training, and other resources needed to protect the public and emergency personnel from fire and related hazard. Across the United States, the AFG awards will ultimately provide approximately \$390 million to fire departments and nonaffiliated emergency medical service organizations throughout the county. AFG's goal is to enhance response capabilities and provide for the protection of the health and safety of the public with respect to fire and other hazards.
