## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The Novi Police Department has accumulated 25-30 soft body armor ballistic vests that have been replaced over the years and are no longer used by the Department. The Department purchases a vest for each officer at the time of hire and then again every five years. The five year replacement schedule follows National Institute of Justice (NIJ) and manufacturer guidelines.


Thousands of law enforcement professionals in the United States and around the world are working in dangerous environments and they do not have a ballistic vest to protect them. In addition, similar to the officers of the Novi Police Department, thousands of officers are provided new ballistic vests every five years. While the manufacturer warranty may be expired, often the vest will still effectively protect those that do not have one. The Armor of God Project began in 2009 and is dedicated to protecting those that protect us. They will recycle used ballistic vests and provide them to officers in need.

The Novi Police Department would like to provide its surplus, obsolete ballistic vests to other first responders that are in need through the Armor of God Project. The value of each unit at the time of purchase was approximately \$650.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Approval to dispose of obsolete ballistic vests by providing them to officers in need through the Vest For Life – Armor of God Project.
