Dear Zoning Board Member,

On September 8th, 2009 the Zoning Board of Appeals approved an 84" diameter sign on the Novi façade of the Bagger Dave's restaurant. This variance was required because both the east and west building elevations are designed as front elevations and require signage for the business identity and customer way-finding.

Bagger Dave's has recently revised their menu and business plan to include breakfast. We are proposing a revision to the previous signage design. The revised signage includes a 75" diameter sign (matching what was previously approved) as well as a 75" x 14" sign reading "Serving Breakfast". The actual signage area is 38 square feet and is less than the previously approved 38.4 sq.ft. Our proposed design has a more complex shape and therefore requires a simple rectangle as our area of calculation. Our new proposed area is 48 square feet. Please see the attached drawings by <u>Krieger</u> <u>Associates</u> and sign specifications by <u>Phillips Sign and Lighting</u> for all dimensions and information regarding the requested signage.
