Good afternoon!

I am writing to inquire about sidewalks planned for Quince Drive south of Ten Mile. This is a major road to Orchard Hills Elementary and cars often travel very quickly in their haste to get to the school. We frequently walk with our grandchild or our dog and it is like running the gauntlet to make it to a sidewalk-equipped street especially when school is in session and we are not allowed to traverse school property. School bus and car traffic is significant on Quince and they often travel at an excess rate of speed. Numerous times I have had to dive off of the road with the stroller to give wide berth to speeding cars. There is a drainage ditch so it is not easy to navigate the roadside with a stroller. High school kids are let off at the corner of Ten Mile and Quince and they have to walk down the middle of the street. Cars often turn quickly off of Ten Mile onto Quince. It is really a tragic accident waiting to happen. I have reviewed the AMP map 2023 but it is not clear when or if sidewalks are planned for Quince based on the description of Item 13 on the map. I am surprised that all of the other sidewalks have been added in the neighborhood but not on the most dangerous stretch of road in close proximity to an elementary school.

Can you please clarify the plans for sidewalks on Quince?
