

CITY OF NOVI CITY COUNCIL DECEMBER 6, 2021

SUBJECT: Approval of Resolution to Transfer Sewage Flow Meter 5730, also known as

BG1, from the City of Novi to the County of Oakland.

SUBMITTING DEPARTMENT: Department of Public Works, Water & Sewer Division

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City of Novi has three sanitary sewage collection systems, the largest of which is the Huron Rouge Sewage Disposal System (HRSDS). This system has one flow meter on Eight Mile, west of Novi Road, which is used to measure all flow from the HRSDS for contractual and billing purposes.

This meter is currently owned and maintained by Novi. However, since the meter resides in pipe owned by Oakland County Water Resource Commission (WRC), transferring ownership of the meter to WRC has been a consideration for some time. Presently, the construction of the HRSDS Retention Facility requires a tie into the data feed from the meter for the facility operation (by WRC). Staff determined the transfer of ownership from Novi to WRC is now appropriate. WRC will assume operation and maintenance of the meter, but the City will maintain the ability to collect meter flow data as needed.

The attached Resolution To Transfer A Sewage Flow Meter 5730 Also Known As BG1 From The City Of Novi To The County Of Oakland has been developed to transfer ownership of the meter to WRC from Novi. The City Attorney has reviewed this resolution and finds it acceptable (Beth Saarela, November 18, 2021).

The following resolution was offered by and seconded by:
WHEREAS the City of Novi currently owns, operates, and maintains a sewage flow
meter commonly referred to as "Meter 5730" or alternatively as "Meter BG1" which measures
the level of sewage flow and converts that level to a flow rate using a flume equation; and
WHEREAS the City of Novi collects the metered flow rate data via a Supervisory
Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) connection and shares it monthly via email with the
Oakland County Water Resources Commissioner's office and the Rouge Valley Sewage
Disposal System; and
WHEREAS both the City of Novi and the County of Oakland, by and through the office

WHEREAS both the City of Novi and the County of Oakland, by and through the office of the Water Resources Commissioner (WRC), desires to transfer the operation and maintenance responsibilities of the meter from the City to the County; and

WHEREAS after careful consideration and review, the City of Novi and the County of Oakland have concluded that the best option for providing continued uninterrupted service to the public served by the Huron-Rouge Sewage Disposal System is the transfer of ownership of the meter, along with any and all operation and maintenance responsibilities, from the City of Novi to the County of Oakland; and

WHEREAS the Water Resources Commissioner, has qualified personnel capable of providing efficient, uninterrupted operations and maintenance services to the meter; and

WHEREAS such transfer would provide greater efficiency to the public served through additional data collection by the WRC and the Huron-Rouge Sewage Disposal System; and

WHEREAS upon completion of such transfer, the City would be released from all operation and maintenance obligations along with any associated costs; and

WHEREAS the City would continue to collect metered flow rate data via a city-owned Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) connection; and

WHEREAS the City would continue to be responsible for the maintenance of its SCADA connection and all associated hardware and software components; and

WHEREAS the County would collect metered flow rate data as well via a separate, county-owned SCADA connection.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City does hereby approve the transfer of Meter 5730 from the City to the County of Oakland, in its current, as-is condition, with no warranties of any kind.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City hereby authorizes and grants binding authority to the Clerk of the City of Novi to execute the transfer from the City to the County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an executed copy of this resolution by the Clerk shall be forwarded to the Oakland County Water Resources Commissioner, located at One Public Works Drive, Waterford, Michigan 48328 to the attention of the Senior Attorney.

SUBJECT: Transfer of a Sewage Flow Meter from the City of Novi to Oakland County

DATE: November 17, 2021

During discussions between my engineering staff and representatives of the City of Novi, it was concluded that the City of Novi would like to transfer ownership of its sewage flow meter referred to as "Meter 5730" or alternatively as "Meter BG1" from the City to Oakland County.

The attached resolution is being offered to accommodate that mutual goal. This proposed transfer will provide continued uninterrupted service to the public served by the Huron-Rouge Sewage Disposal System. In addition to the ownership transfer, all operation and maintenance responsibilities and any associated costs will be transferred as well.

I would also note that the City currently collects metered flow data via a Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) connection and shares the collected information with my office and with the Rouge Valley Sewage Disposal System. This transfer would not impact that collection of data. The City would continue to collect data via a city-owned SCADA connection. At the same time, the County will collect data as well via a separate, county-owned SCADA connection.

This resolution is evidence that the well-established cooperation between the City of Novi and Oakland County continues unabated. Once you have adopted the resolution, I will shepherd it through the process of adoption by the Oakland County Board of Commissioners.
