SUBJECT: Approval to award bid for ball field fencing replacement and repair at ITC Community Sports Park and Ella Mae Power Park to RMD Holdings, Ltd. d/b/a Nationwide Construction Corporation, in the amount of \$25,908.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: City Council approved the replacement and repair of fencing at ITC Community Sports Park and Ella Mae Power Park in the FY 2012-13 budget to replace and repair broken fencing hardware and bent metal fabric. The project will address outfield and/or back stop fencing maintenance concerns on a total of 10 ball fields.

The Original fencing installed at ITC Community Sports Park and on fields 5-6 at Power Park is in disrepair and is no longer functional. Both of these facilities continue to provide recreational opportunities, such as baseball, softball, cricket, football and soccer for both youth and adults. Today, both facilities host 20-24 tournaments annually, in addition to numerous internal and community programs. Each of these events creates a great economic benefit to the surrounding business in the community.

After repairs are completed will enhance safety and aesthetics at each facility, and reduce maintenance and annual repair costs. Once repairs are complete, user groups will be provided with a greater level of service through the programs and administered by the Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services team.

Two (2) bids were received and opened on Wednesday July 10, 2013 following a public bid solicitation period. The lowest bidder is RMD Holdings, Ltd. d/b/a Nationwide Construction Corporation. Although the lowest bidder has not provided fencing repair services for the City in the past, the references provided support a recommendation for award. Nationwide Construction Corporation's bid is recommended as being in the best interest of the City, as it is responsive (i.e. the contractor has complied with all requirements of the bidding instructions), and it is the lowest price. A summary of the 2 bids are as follows:

The repair and replacement of fencing is scheduled to begin in late summer and will be substantially complete by early fall.

BALL FIELD FENCING REPLACEMENT AND REPAIR

SPECIFICATIONS

GENERAL SCOPE

The City intends to select a contractor to replace existing fencing on ball fields, provide some repair to posts, and some fence line adjustments according to specifications. Existing fence which is removed by the contractor is the property of the City of Novi and will be disposed of by the City.

MANDATORY PRE-BID MEETING

Specific locations of replacement and repair will be marked at the pre-bid meeting site visit and the contractor will be responsible for taking actual measurements at that time.

TIMELINE

All field work and necessary inspections must be completed by September 30, 2013. Payment will be contingent upon complete installation and final inspection and approval of the work by the Parks & Forestry Asset Manager or his designee.

PROJECT LOCATIONS

All Measurements are approximate. It is the contractor's responsibility to obtain accurate measurements on which to bid. Maps showing field locations within the parks are included as part of this document.

CITY OF NOVI INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS ATTACHMENT A

- The Contractor shall maintain at its expense during the term of this Contract, the following insurance:
 - Worker's Compensation insurance with the Michigan statutory limits and Employer's Liability insurance with minimum limits of \$100,000 (One Hundred Thousand Dollars) each accident.
 - b. Commercial General Liability Insurance The Contractor shall procure and maintain during the life of this contract, Commercial General Liability Insurance, Personal Injury, Bodily Injury and Property Damage on an "Occurrence Basis" with limits of liability not less than \$1,000,000 (One Million Dollars) per occurrence combined single limit.
 - c. Automobile Liability insurance covering all owned, hired and non-owned vehicles with Personal Protection insurance to comply with the provisions of the Michigan No Fault Insurance Law including Residual Liability insurance with minimum bodily injury limits of \$1,000,000 (One Million Dollars) each person and \$1,000,000 (One Million Dollars) each occurrence and minimum property damage limits of \$1,000,000 (One Million Dollars) each occurrence.
- 2. All policies shall name the Contractor as the insured and shall be accompanied by a commitment from the insurer that such policies shall not be canceled or reduced without at least thirty (30) days prior notice date to the City; alternately, contractor may agree to provide notice of such cancellation or reduction.
- 3. The City of Novi shall be named as Additional Insured for General Liability and Auto Liability. Certificates of Insurance evidencing such coverage shall be submitted to City of Novi, Purchasing Department, 45175 West Ten Mile Road, Novi, Michigan 48375-3024 prior to commencement of performance under this Contract and at least fifteen (15) days prior to the expiration dates of expiring policies. A current certificate of insurance must be on file with the City for the duration of the contract. Said coverage shall be primary coverage rather than any policies and insurance self-insurance retention owned or maintained by the City. Policies shall be issued by insurers who endorse the policies to reflect that, in the event of payment of any loss or damages, subrogation rights under those contract documents will be waived by the insurer with respect to claims against the City
- 4. The Contractor shall be responsible for payment of all deductibles contained in any insurance required hereunder.

- 5. If, during the term of this Contract, changed conditions or other pertinent factors should in the reasonable judgment of the City render inadequate insurance limits, the Contractor will furnish on demand such additional coverage as may reasonably be required under the circumstances. All such insurance shall be effected at the Contractor's expense, under valid and enforceable policies, issued by the insurers of recognized responsibility which are well-rated by national rating organizations and are acceptable to the City.
- 6. If any work is sublet in connection with this Contract, the Contractor shall require each subcontractor to effect and maintain at least the same types and limits of insurance as fixed for the Contractor.
- 7. The provisions requiring the Contractor to carry said insurance shall not be construed in any manner as waiving or restricting the liability of the Contractor under this contract.
- 8. The City has the authority to vary from the specified limits as deemed necessary.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

HOLD HARMLESS/INDEMNITY

- 1. The Contractor agrees to fully defend, indemnify and hold harmless the City, its City Council, its officers, employees, agents, volunteers and contractors from any claims, demands, losses, obligations, costs, expenses, verdicts, and settlements (including but not limited to attorney fees and interest) resulting from:
- A. Acts or omissions by the Contractor, its agents, employees, servants and contractors in furtherance of execution of this Agreement, unless resulting from the sole negligence and tort of the City, its officers, employees, agents and contractors.
- B. Violations of state or federal law involving whether administrative or judicial, arising from the nature and extent of this Agreement.
- C. The Contractor agrees to defend the City from and against any and all actions or causes of action, claims, demands or whatsoever kind or nature arising from the operations of the Contractor and due to the acts or omissions of the Contractor or its agents, including, but not limited to, acts of omissions alleged to be in the nature of gross negligence or willful misconduct. The Contractor agrees to reimburse the City for reasonable attorney fees and court costs incurred in the defense of any actions, suits, claims or demands arising from the operations of the Contractor under this Agreement due to the above-referenced acts or omissions.
- 2. The Contractor agrees that it is its responsibility and not the responsibility of the City of safeguard the property and materials used in performing this Contract. Further the Contractor agrees to hold the City harmless for any loss of such property and materials used in pursuant to the Contractor's performance under this Contract.
- 3. The Contractor shall not discriminate against any employee, or applicant for employment because of religion, race, color, national origin, age, sex, height, weight, handicap, ancestry, place of birth, sexual preference or marital status. The Contractor further covenants that it will comply with the Civil Rights Act of 1973, as amended; and the Michigan Civil Rights Act of 1976 (78. Stat. 252 and 1976 PA 453) and will require a similar covenant on the part of any consultant or subcontractor employed in the performance of this contract.

- The mandatory pre-bid meeting attendance requirement is waived for South Lyon Fence. They will be permitted to submit a bid without attending the pre-bid meeting.
- The Contractor will be responsible for disposing of all removed fencing & debris generated by the work.

QUESTIONS:

- Can another fence material be substituted for the galvanized fence?
 Answer: We will allow aluminized chain link fabric for the 16 foot high fencing only. Please identify if you are making this substitution in the Comments section of the bid form.
- Who is removing the post anchors?
 Answer: The City will remove anchors prior to contractor beginning the work.


