SUBJECT: Approval of a traffic control device maintenance agreement with the Road Commission for Oakland County for the existing traffic signal at 12 Mile Road and Cabot Drive.

SUBMITTING DEPARTMENT: Department of Public Services, Engineering Division

CITY MANAGER APPROVAL

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC) has provided the attached Agreement for Traffic Control Device for the existing traffic signal at the intersection of westbound 12 Mile Road and Cabot Drive. The signal was constructed in 2006 under construction agreements between Northern Equities, the City of Novi and the Road Commission for Oakland County. However, a maintenance agreement covering the ongoing maintenance costs for the signal was never executed between the City and RCOC.

The Agreement for Traffic Control Device formally allocates the maintenance costs for the traffic signal based on the jurisdictions of the streets at the intersection. Since there are three legs to the intersection, RCOC would cover two-thirds of the costs for eastbound and westbound 12 Mile Road and Novi would cover one-third of the costs for Cabot Drive, which is under Novi jurisdiction. This allocation matches the maintenance billing that has occurred since the signal was installed. Routine maintenance costs for a typical traffic signal are approximately \$2,500 per year.

The proposed agreement has been reviewed and recommended for approval by Engineering staff and the City Attorney (Beth Saarela's July 30, 2013 letter attached).

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Approval of a traffic control device maintenance agreement with the Road Commission for Oakland County for the existing traffic signal at 12 Mile Road and Cabot Drive.

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

STATE OF MICHIGAN BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD COMMISSIONERS OAKLAND COUNTY AGREEMENT FOR TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE

Type of Work: Traffic Signal Maintenance

Location: Twelve Mile Road & Cabot Drive

Signal No: 1245 Date Effective:

Under authority of state law and by virtue of resolution formally adopted by their respective governing bodies, the under-signed hereby agree to participate in the cost of installation, maintenance and operation of the above traffic control device on the basis of the following division of costs. (Title to equipment shall remain with the purchasing agency, unless purchased for roads not under the jurisdiction of the Board of County Road Commissioner.) The proportionate share of all costs are to be billed monthly. This agreement is terminable on thirty days written notice by any party.

It is further agreed that the agency responsible for payment of energy billings and/or leased line interconnection billings included in maintenance costs, shall be the ROAD COMMISSION FOR OAKLAND COUNTY.

It is further agreed that the agency responsible for making original and replacement installations and performing maintenance shall be the ROAD COMMISSION FOR OAKLAND COUNTY.

"In the event the traffic control device referred to in this agreement is located on a road or street that is not under the jurisdiction of the Road Commission for Oakland County, the authority having the jurisdiction over the road or street hereby agrees to save harmless, indemnify, represent, and defend the Road Commission for Oakland County from any and all claims, demands, or suits arising out of or relating to the installation, maintenance and operation of the traffic control device which is the subject matter of this agreement."

"In the event the traffic control device referred to in this agreement is located on a road or street that is under the jurisdiction of the Road Commission for Oakland County and by virtue of this agreement will be maintained by an agency other than the Road Commission for Oakland County, then and in that event the said agency hereby acknowledges that it is undertaking the Road Commission for Oakland County's duty to maintain the said traffic control device and further agrees to provide insurance coverage protecting the Road Commission for Oakland County."

RE: Agreement with Road Commission for Oakland County Twelve Mile and Cabot Drive Traffic Signal

Dear Mr. Coburn:

Our office has reviewed the proposed Agreement for consideration by City Council prepared by RCOC with respect to sharing the cost of maintaining the traffic control devices at the intersections of Twelve Mile and Cabot Drive.

Under the Agreement, RCOC's contribution to the cost of maintenance is 66 2/3 % and the City's portion is 33 1/3 %. The Agreement states that RCOC will conduct all maintenance and the City will reimburse RCOC for its portion. The Agreement indicates RCOC will pay for energy billings and/or leased line interconnection billings.

This Agreement, like the previous traffic signal agreements between the City and RCOC requires the City to indemnify and hold harmless the County for claims relating to the traffic control device in the event that device is located on a road or street *other than a country road*. Corporation counsel for the County has refused to modify the provision on previous occasions. Though Cabot Drive is not a County road, corporation counsel for the County has previously asserted that when this provision does not apply when the intersection includes a County road. Additionally, as we previously noted, recent case law provides that the County is immune from liability pursuant to the governmental immunity statute because traffic signals are not included in the definition of "highway." *Johnson-McIntosh v City of Detroit*, 266 Mich App 318 (2005). Therefore, in the event of an injury or other damages relating to the traffic control device, the County would very possibly be immune and this provision would in that event, have no effect on the City.

Additionally, the requirement to provide RCOC with insurance in this case is inapplicable because RCOC is completing the maintenance.

Subject to the limited possibility for liability relating to the signal on Cabot Drive as set forth above, we see no legal impediment to entering into the Agreement.
