# 2. Program Updates (Golles)

Dance Classes – Youth dance recital is taking place on May 1. There will be two separate performances to accommodate the group size. Michelle has taught for Chelsea in the past so it should be a smooth transition. Chelsea will still maintain contact with the program while she is gone, and will plan to return to teaching when she is back.

Polynesian Dance Classes – Have had a strong winter season, and will begin again next week. Summer classes will move outdoors to Fuerst Park for the summer, taking advantage of the stage space there.

Mexico Lindo Classes – Participation numbers are still low, have had a hard time bringing those classes back after COVID. Met with instructors to discuss challenges and solutions, including moving the class to a different week night to see if that bumps numbers up.

Theatre – High School musical Jr. opens Thursday 4/7 at 7pm. We have 76 kids between two casts for this show. Ticket sales are strong and expected to do well through the weekend. The license request has been submitted for our fall show, auditions will take place in September and the show date will be pushed back to January 2023.

Glass Fusion – classes continue to be popular. The instructor is working on new ideas for future projects.

KidCreate Classes – Registration continues to be irregular. We will continue to offer a variety of classes and programs.

Choralaires (Becky Staab) – The Choralaires Spring performance will be taking place on May 7 at Novi High School.

Concert Band (Stephanie Hall) – the Concert Band will be performing with the Schoolcraft Wind Ensemble on April 24 at the Library. Their spring performance will be taking place on May 8 at the Civic Center.
