**RESOLUTION OF THE ELECTION COMMISSION TO REVISE THE  
BOUNDARIES OF VOTING PRECINCTS IN THE CITY OF NOVI**

At a meeting of the City of Novi Election Commission, Oakland County, Michigan, held in the City Hall at 45175 Ten Mile Road, Novi, Michigan 48375, on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2025 at 3:30 p.m.

The following preamble and Resolution were offered by Commissioner \_\_\_\_ and supported by Commissioner \_\_\_\_.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Novi has 25 voting precincts and 21 polling locations, as established in 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the rearrangement of precinct boundaries are governed under Michigan Election Law, MCL 168.654-661; and

**WHEREAS**, all planned precinct boundary changes must be approved by the local Election Commission and by the City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, Michigan Election Law was modified to allow up to 4,999 active registered voters in a precinct; and

**WHEREAS**, significant changes have been made to Michigan Election laws, including early voting and maintaining a permanent ballot list; and

**WHEREAS**, while it is likely that further changes will be proposed to precinct boundaries in the future to permanently consolidate precincts based on real

data, staff is proposing to consolidate Precinct 16 and 17 into one precinct with approximately 3,400 registered voters; and

**WHEREAS**, combining these precincts into one will save the City an average of \$1,300 per election.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the City of Novi Election Commission approves the precinct boundary changes to permanently consolidate Precinct 16 and 17 into one precinct called Precinct 16.

**MICHIGAN ELECTION LAW (EXCERPT)**  
**Act 116 of 1954**

**168.658 Election precincts; consolidation.**

Sec. 658. If a city, ward, township, or village is divided into 2 or more election precincts, pursuant to law, and it appears from an examination of the precinct registration records that there are not more than 4,999 active registered electors in the city, ward, township, or village, the election commission, or other officials charged with the performance of the duty by the charter of a city or village, by resolution, may abolish the division or divisions and after that time the city, ward, township, or village constitutes a single election precinct as if a division had not been made. A consolidation must not be made later than the 120 days before a primary or election.
