OPEN, INCLUSIVE AND FISCALLY STRONG

hile budget constraints force communities to cut services and eliminate jobs across the country, the City of Novi's history of sound fiscal management allows it to survive and thrive through economic challenges.

In 2008, Standard & Poor's credit rating agency upgraded the City of Novi to an AA+ rating and affirmed it in 2010. The rating reflects the City's strong financial performance and capacity to meet its financial commitments. Also in 2010, the City received an Aa2 rating from Moody's, a level only achieved by a small percent of the nation's communities. The fiscal fitness demonstrated by City leaders is the result of a municipal culture promoting discipline, focus and attention to the priorities of its citizenry.

Novi's successful government welcomes citizen involvement and is making it as simple as a click of the mouse to follow community fiscal

developments. In 2011, the City introduced an open government icon to its website (cityofnovi.org) allowing easy dashboard access to City council agendas, budget information, and televised government programs. For instance, residents can see exactly how much of each tax dollar they pay helps the City pay for services like public safety and community development.

In 2010, Novi saw \$23 million added to its tax base, with 49 percent of that amount coming from residential taxes. Not only is Novi now one of the top three communities in Oakland County, based on taxable value, balanced growth demonstrates the City is expanding both business and population.



assistance team, distribution of the e-biz monthly electronic newsletter, advertising and monthly local televisions shows highlighting the community's large and small businesses. Novi Television "Corporate Review" takes viewers onsite to Novi's large employers. "Business Avenue" highlights the community's small business operators.

Clearly a city on the move, Novi embraces a variety of strategies for generating economic vitality, such as a high level of assistance for entrepreneurial advancement. The University of Michigan Center for Innovative Research noted, "The City of Novi is part of an elite group of Michigan communities helping to understand and share efforts that foster entrepreneurship and encourage business development."

Assisting in economic development. Novi recently took steps to enliven its entrepreneurial culture through a partnership with the MORE Program (Matching Opportunities and Resources for Entrepreneurs), a U.S. Department of Labor funded nonprofit organization. Based in Detroit, MORE created InsYght, a web-based tool connecting entrepreneurs to business resources. By linking the entrepreneur to institutions providing research facilities, expert advice or funding, the time between ideas to implementation is reduced. The result: companies get off the ground and into the marketplace as quickly as possible. As the program evolves, InsYght is expected to serve as a portal to 26,000



entrepreneurial resources.

City leaders recognize the need for speed in today's competitive business environment. They have streamlined business processes, updated ordinances and facilitate cohesive government partnerships, making Novi a highly desirable location to do business. In addition, the City participates in a variety of business

incentive programs ranging from tax abatements for new facilities, redevelopment and expansions.





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
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




Did you know...

- ▶ The City has installed **two charging stations** for those who drive an electric or plug-in hybrid vehicle.
- Novi was honored by Oakland County with the prestigious 2010 Green Community Award for its outstanding leadership in green initiatives.
- ▶ Novi has been recognized as **one of the top places to live and work nationally** by both Family Circle and Money Magazine.



NOVI EMPLOYEE STATISTICS BY NAICS CODE






INTERNATIONAL COMPANIES LOCATED IN NOVI






MOST COMMON OCCUPATIONS







LAND USE (in acres)




