BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City of Novi contracts Electrical services for the following municipal facilities: Civic Center, Police Station, Indoor Gun Range, Department of Public Services, CEMS Building, Fire Stations 1, 2, 3, and 4. Additionally, we have included an option to allow the Library and Meadowbrook Commons to leverage this contract, should they choose, for services not covered by existing warranties. The scope of services provided by the vendor is as follows: electrical repairs, new wiring, electrical service connections and emergency repairs.

This request for proposals was posted on the Michigan Intergovernmental Trade Network (MITN). This process resulted in three vendor proposals for this service. A team comprised of City staff reviewed the proposals. The team evaluated the firm's qualifications, and costing for hourly rates and material markup. After careful review it is the recommendation of this team to award the Electrical Services contract to Great Lakes Power and Lighting, Inc.
