

MDOT PROJECTS



I-96 Freeway Flex Route

MDOT plans to conduct a full freeway closure of EB I-96 from Wixom to Novi for overhead sign installation on Saturday, November 11, from 5 a.m. to 1 p.m. The posted detour will be EB I-96 to EB Grand River to NB Novi to EB I-96.

After the sign installation is complete, construction operations will begin winding down for a seasonal stoppage before resuming again in the spring for westbound construction. Until that time, EB I-96, Kent Lake Road to I-275, will have two lanes open. The NB/SB Wixom Road onramps to EB I-96 and the NB Novi Road on-ramp to EB I-96 are now open.

The remaining ramps will be reopened by early December:

- EB I-96 off-ramp to Novi Road
- SB Novi Road on-ramp to EB I-96
- NB/SB Beck Road on-ramp to EB I-96

Rebuilding Michigan I-696 Project

Activities will shut down in November and resume again in the spring of 2024. At that time, traffic will have been shifted onto the new eastbound lanes while they reconstruct the westbound lanes.

RCOC PROJECTS

14 Mile Road Simple Asphalt Resurfacing

RCOC is currently paving 14 Mile Road from Haggerty Road to East Lake Drive. The road remains open, with flaggers directing traffic in the work zone.

Please expect delays as RCOC continues work.

GLWA 54-INCH TRANSMISSION WATER MAIN



Meadowbrook Road Between 12 and 13 Mile Road

GLWA will resume pipe installation later this month on Meadowbrook Road between 12 and 13 Mile Roads.

This work is anticipated to be completed over the winter. Pavement work in this section is expected to be complete in the spring of 2024.

13 Mile Road

GLWA completed restoration work on 13 Mile and opened all lanes to traffic.

Construction operations will resume when the City of Novi takes over the remainder of the reconstruction project next summer when school is out of session. During this portion of the project, 13 Mile Road will again be open to one-way traffic only, but for a limited time and with no school traffic adding to the congestion.

11 Mile Road

Paving operations are currently underway on 11 Mile Road and Seeley, working their way toward Meadowbrook. Be prepared for intermittent flagging as GLWA conducts work in the area.

Taft Road Rehabilitation

The contractor is currently placing permanent pavement markings on Taft Road, which is anticipated to be completed today. While the crew conducts work, be prepared for potential delays.

Important Information

Project schedules are only estimates. Work could be delayed for a number of factors, such as inclement weather.

Motorists should expect delays while work is in progress.

Driveway access may be impacted for residents located within the work zone
