BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

For several years, the City Council has made it a goal to invest annually in neighborhood streets to maintain the City's local road network. To implement this goal, the City selects several residential streets to be addressed based on an evaluation of the pavement condition using PASER ratings, field observations by staff, and resident concerns. The 2013 Neighborhood Road Program will implement the City's Asset Management approach for pavements that was established in 2009. This project includes multiple treatment methods which were determined during the design process based on our asset management approach, focused on preventative maintenance where appropriate and designed to extend the life of the City's roads in the most cost-effective manner.

The asset management program stresses the importance of using preventative maintenance to preserve good quality roads using low-cost rehabilitation techniques, rather than allowing the roads to deteriorate to a point that requires reconstruction involving much more effort at a higher cost. Roads that have deteriorated significantly will be addressed with rehabilitation methods such as overlays, panel replacements, and joint repairs to allow more efficient application of available road funds to maximize the number of neighborhood streets included in each year in the program.

This award is the second contract being awarded for the 2013 construction season and addresses the rehabilitation of asphalt streets listed below (also see attached map):

The asphalt streets to be rehabilitated by milling off the existing pavement and repaving (overlay) will also include a pavement interlayer intended to reduce reflective cracking and to prevent water infiltration through the pavement into the base layers. The interlayer is intended to extend the useful life of the pavement. Two types of interlayers were selected as alternates for this contract; one is a polypropylene nonwoven fabric, and the other is a spray applied emulsion with imbedded fiberglass. Following review of the bids, the fabric interlayer was selected for this construction contract since it was significantly cheaper, and it is a product staff has some familiarity with as it has been used previously for a road rehabilitation project.

The Capital Preventative Maintenance component of this year's program involves the application of a slurry seal, which is an asphalt emulsion applied to the surface of the road. Slurry seals are typically used on roads that are in good condition with only minor defects to seal the surface and prolong the useful life of the pavement.

Six (6) bids were received and opened on May 22, 2013 following a public bid solicitation period. The lowest bidder is Cadillac Asphalt. Cadillac's bid is recommended as being in the best interest of the City as it is responsive (i.e., Cadillac has complied with all requirements of the bidding instructions) and it is the lowest price. (URS' award recommendation letter including the bid tabulation dated May 23, 2013 is attached.) A summary of the six bids is as follows:


This project was included in the FY2012-13 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) in the budgeted amount of \$1,300,000 for construction of which \$338,477 was awarded for the first construction contract (Concrete-Contract 1) and \$662,772 is now being recommended for award to Cadillac for this construction contract (Contract 2). There is \$298,751 remaining in the FY12-13 budget for construction and an additional \$300,000 (approved in the FY13-14 budget) available for construction award after July 1. Staff may recommend award of a third contract this construction season or may recommend change orders to the existing two contracts. A recommendation from staff on the award of the remaining \$598,751 of construction funding for the 2013 construction season will be forthcoming by late June.

Construction of the project will begin this summer and be substantially complete this construction season.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Approval to award a construction contract for the 2013 Neighborhood Road Program—Contract 2 (Asphalt) to Cadillac Asphalt LLC, the low bidder, in the amount of \$662,772.

Dear Mr. Croy:

Attached is the Bid Tabulation for the above referenced project. Six (6) bids were received and opened. Competition appears to have been adequate.

There are minor arithmetic errors in the bids received from Pavex Corporation. After corrections, the order of bidders did not change. Pavex Corporation submitted a bid; however, they did not receive plans directly from URS, were not on the bidders list, and did not receive the addenda issued for the project. No other irregularities were noted in the bids.

We have worked previously with the low bidder, Cadillac Asphalt, LLC and they have performed well on similar projects. The bonding company listed in their statement of qualifications has A.M. Best Key rating of "A", which exceeds the minimum requirements.

We therefore recommend award of the Base Bid plus Alternate 1 to Cadillac Asphalt LLC for the Bid Amount, excluding crew day costs, of \$662,772.
