**SUBJECT:** Approval of Traffic Controls Order 25-02 through 25-03 for the implementation of No Parking Zones around the islands at the two intersections of Stonehenge Blvd. and N. Rockledge Blvd.

**SUBMITTING DEPARTMENT:** Department of Public Works, Engineering Division

**KEY HIGHLIGHTS:**

- The roads in Stonehenge are not the standard 28 feet
- Two triangular islands introduce visibility problems for motorists with parked cars

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The two triangular islands (see map) in the Stonehenge Condominium development are causing visibility issues which can be made worse with parked cars. The overall width could also hinder emergency access. Therefore, TCOs 25-02 and 25-03 propose to prevent on-street parking along the island side of the islands at the two intersections of Stonehenge Blvd and N. Rockledge Blvd.

Traffic control orders are required under the Uniform Traffic Code to enforce traffic control signs installed on public streets. Staff prepared the following traffic control orders for approval by City Council.

TCO No.	Description
25-02	No Parking on all three sides of northern triangular island at N. Rockledge Blvd
25-03	No Parking on all three sides of southern triangular island at N. Rockledge Blvd

**RECOMMENDED ACTION:** Approval of Traffic Controls Order 25-02 through 25-03 for the implementation of No Parking Zones around the islands at the two intersections of Stonehenge Blvd. and N. Rockledge Blvd.

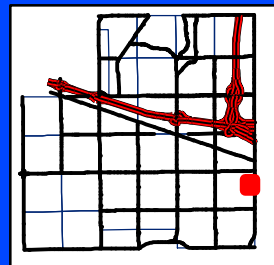
