PAPER

Flattened Cardboard

Paperboard Boxes
(cereal, pasta, facial tissue boxes, etc.)

**Paper Cups
Milk, Juice & Soup Cartons**

**Office Paper, Junk Mail
& Magazines**

Newspapers & Inserts, Phone Books

Gift Wrap, File Folders, Paper Bags

*NO FACIAL TISSUE, PAPER TOWELS,
TISSUE PAPER, OR PAPER WITH GLITTER/FOIL*



Throw away straws, lids and caps



No foam or foam lined cups;
throw away stirrers, lids and straws



OK to leave staples, clips, labels, stamps, bindings,
and metal fasteners on paper products



Clean pizza boxes only - no grease or food

**Plastic Jugs, Bottles &
Containers: #1, #2, #4 - #7**

Garden Plastics

NO FOAM/STYROFOAM



Leave lids and caps on



Remove soil and plants

METAL

Steel & Aluminum

Bottles & Cans

Pots & Pans

NO PAINT CANS



GLASS

Glass Bottles & Jars
(all colors)

*NO WINDOW PANES, CERAMICS, MIRRORS,
DISHWARE, COOKWARE, OR BAKEWARE*



NOT ACCEPTED CURBSIDE OR AT DROP-OFF SITES:

(check rrrasoc.org for more info)

- Plastic bags
- Waxed cardboard (freezer boxes)
- Shredded Paper
- Organics & Food Waste
- Tanglers (wire hangers, hoses, wire, string lights, extension cords, etc.)
- Electronic waste (batteries, cell phones, computers, etc.)
- Medical Waste (needles, syringes, tubing, etc.)
- Hazardous waste (paint, pesticides, oil, cleaners, etc.)

HOW TO PREPARE YOUR RECYCLABLES:



Recyclables should be
EMPTY, CLEAN, and DRY



DO NOT BAG RECYCLABLES;
leave recyclables loose



Include only listed items; check
RECYCLING DIRECTORY if unsure



Return grocery bags to
participating stores for
recycling
